Words and Definitions

Cashier – A person in charge of payments and receipts for a business.

Cottage Cheese – White, soft, lumpy curds of soured milk.

Dairy – Milk products.

Eggplant – A purple, oval-shaped fruit eaten as a vegetable

Eggs – Oval-shaped food with a shell containing a jelly substance.

Fruit – Sweet, edible product with seeds and produced by plants.

Grains – Wheat or any cereal crop used as food.

Grocery Store – A store that sells food products.

Kale – Dark green hard cabbage vegetable with stems.

Milk – White fluid made of protein and fat.

Mustard Greens – The leaves of mustard plants and sometimes used in salads.

Plum – An oval-shaped fruit usually a purple or reddish color.

Produce – Food products that have been grown or produced.

Register – A tool used to calculate charges and payments for purchases.

Shopping List – A list of purchases to be made.

Squash – An edible fruit from a squash plant.

Vegetables – Part of plants used as food.

Whole Wheat Pasta – Pasta made from whole wheat.

Wild Rice – The grain of wild rice plants used as food.

Yogurt – Soft food made with fermented milk.
